This year there will be a specific emphasis on energy connectivity and issues related to the Middle Corridor. Participants will engage in discussions on diverse topics such as energy fundamentals, energy law and economics, environmental issues, climate change, oil and gas management, carbon capture and sequestration, along with insights from major energy companies including SOCAR and BP.

The Baku Summer Energy School presents extensive networking opportunities with global leaders from the public and private sectors. Participants will have the opportunity to engage with key speakers, including the Minister of Foreign Affairs, Minister of Energy, and Minister of Ecology and Natural Resources of Azerbaijan, as well as executives from leading energy companies like SOCAR, BP, Masdar, GL, Kolin and more.

Ambassador Dr. Hafiz Pashayev

Rector, ADA University

Ambassador Hafiz Pashayev is the Deputy Minister of Foreign Affairs of the Republic of Azerbaijan and the founding Rector of ADA University. He was the first and longest serving Ambassador Extraordinary and Plenipotentiary of the Republic of Azerbaijan to the United States (1992-2006), also being accredited in the United Mexican States and Canada. Upon completion of his diplomatic tenure Mr. Pashayev returned to Baku to establish the Azerbaijan Diplomatic Academy, which has grown under his leadership from the training center for diplomats into a full-fledged university with four schools, offering graduate and undergraduate degree programs.

A scholar himself, Hafiz Pashayev received his bachelor's degree in physics from the Azerbaijan State University in 1963 and joined the Physics Institute of the Azerbaijan National Academy of Sciences, advancing from the position of the researcher to the head of the Metal Physics laboratory over the years. He got his PhD in Solid-State Physics in 1971 and full Doctorate in 1984. In 1975-1976, he became a visiting researcher scholar at the University of California, Irvine. Professor Pashayev has authored more than hundred scientific articles and two monographs in the field of Physics. He published two books- "Racing Up the Hill" (2006)and "Manifesto of an Ambassador" (2007) based on his memoirs of diplomatic service in Washington, D.C.



Dr. Fariz Ismailzade

Vice Rector, ADA University; Director of the Institute for Development and Diplomacy

Dr. Fariz Ismailzade is Vice Rector for Government, External and Student Affairs at ADA University, Director of the Institute for Development and Diplomacy (IDD), Board member of State Examination Center (since 2016) and visiting research fellow at Princeton University (2021).

Dr. Ismailzade has done research at the Center for Strategic and International Studies (CSIS) in Washington, D.C and Embassy of Azerbaijan in the US. His research interests include political affairs in the Caucasus and Central Asia, energy security, and development. He has presented papers at the symposiums at Heritage Foundation, MGIMO, Columbia University, Stanford University, Fletcher School of Law and Diplomacy, UCLA, Vienna Diplomatic Academy as well as at international conferences such as Association for Study of Nationalities (ASN), Wilton Park Conferences, Middle East Studies Association (MESA), German Marshall Fund and NATO Advanced Research Workshop.

Dr. Ismailzade received his Doctoral Degree from the Maastricht School of Management. He holds an Executive MBA from IE Business School (Spain), and a master's degree in Social and Economic Development from Washington University in St. Louis, and a bachelor's degree in Political Science from Western University in Baku with one-year interim studies at Wesleyan University in Connecticut.



Dr. Elnur Soltanov

Deputy Minister of Energy of the Republic of Azerbaijan

Dr. Elnur Soltanov is the Deputy Minister of Energy of the Republic of Azerbaijan. Dr. Elnur Soltanov has been appointed as Chief Executive Officer of COP29 Azerbaijan as of January 2024.

Prior to his current position, he was involved in pedagogical activities at Texas Tech University, Slippery Rock University and Truman State University during the period 2004-2009. Also, he worked at ADA University as a Professor, Director of the Caspian Energy and Environment Center, and Dean at the School of Public and International Relations during the period 2009-2018. By the order of the President of the Republic of Azerbaijan of January 23, 2021, Mr. Soltanov was appointed a Member of the Supervisory Board of State Oil Company of the Republic of Azerbaijan.

Mr. Soltanov holds bachelor and Master's degrees in international relations at the Middle East Technical University in Turkey. He completed a PhD on Political Sciences at Texas Tech University, USA during the period 2003-2009.



Ms. Ziba Mustafayeva Vice President, SOCAR

Ms. Mustafayeva started her career at "Azercell Telekom" LLC in 2000. Since January 2000, Ziba worked as a junior representative in the Customer Service department, and since November was promoted to lead the Telemarketing group. Between 2001-2004, Ziba Mustafayeva worked as a group leader of the Telephone Contact Center of the Customer Relations Department. In 2004-2006, Mustafayeva joined the Human Resources Department and worked as a representative of the Branch Management and Internal Communication Department, in 2006-2008, as the head of the Recruitment and Business Units Management Department, and in 2008-2010, as the head of the Organizational Development Department. From July 30, 2010, Mustafayeva became the head of the Human Resources Department, and in December, she was promoted to director of the department, followed by a new position as the director of the Human Capital Management Department from July 1, 2019, to February 14, 2022.

From March 2022, Mustafayeva worked as an adviser to the first vice president of SOCAR, and from July of the same year as an adviser to the president of SOCAR. By the Decree of the President of the Republic of Azerbaijan Mr. Ilham Aliyev dated July 28, 2023, Ziba Mustafayeva was appointed as the vice president of the State Oil Company of Azerbaijan Republic.

In 1996, Ziba entered the International Economic Relations department of the Azerbaijan State University of Economics, graduating in 2001 a BA, and then receiving an MA Degree from the same department in 2003. In 1998-1999, Ziba successfully passed the competition of the "FSA" program of the US Embassy and studied General Economics at the University of Alabama in Huntsville, USA.

Bakhtiyar has been with bp for about 20 years and has held a number of leadership roles across communications and external affairs, tax and customs, ethics and compliance as well as business services.

Orkhan Zeynalov is a seasoned professional with over 20 years of experience in international development, diplomacy, and policy, with a strong track record in energy, climate, transport, and regional cooperation.

He has served in key diplomatic postings in New Delhi, Vienna, Tehran, and Washington, D.C., and held leadership roles in multilateral organizations, including as Director for Energy, Minerals and Environment at the ECO Secretariat, where he led delegations to COP21 and the UN Sustainable Development Summit. From 2020 to 2022, he was Director for International Cooperation at Azerbaijan's Ministry of Energy, leading strategic negotiations with the EU and Turkmenistan. He returned to the Foreign Ministry as Director of Economic Cooperation and played a leading role in COP29 preparations. In April 2024, he was appointed Deputy Minister of Energy.

Prof. Brenda Shaffer is an international energy and foreign policy specialist, focusing on politics and energy in the Caspian region, energy security policies, European energy security, ethnic politics in Iran, and Eastern Mediterranean energy. She is a faculty member at the U.S. Naval Postgraduate School. Prof. Shaffer is also Senior Advisor for Energy at the Foundation for Defense of Democracies (FDD) think tank and a Senior Fellow at the Atlantic Council's Global Energy Center in Washington, DC. Prof. Shaffer frequently provides research and expert counsel to international institutions, governments, energy companies, financial institutions, and regional security organizations. Shaffer has served as an advisor to Israel's Prime Minister's Office and Ministry of Energy on policy related to the major natural gas discoveries in Israel. She has advised several companies involved in Caspian energy production and export. She has given testimony to several committees of the US Congress, including the Senate Foreign Relations Committee, and to the European Parliament. Brenda frequently appears on Bloomberg TV and in major news outlets worldwide to provide insight on developments in the global oil market.

Fuad Huseyn oglu Akhundov is an Azerbaijani journalist, television presenter, guide, and prominent researcher of Baku's history and architecture. Known for his engaging storytelling and deep knowledge of the city's past, he has authored and hosted several historical programs, including "Bakı Sirrləri" (Secrets of Baku) on Public Television from 2006 to 2011 and "Əsrlər, Nəsillər" (Centuries, Generations) on AzTV since 2020. He regularly contributes to media outlets such as AZERTAC, Bakinskiy Rabochiy, Vışka, 525-ci qəzet, and various journals including Baku and Azerbaijan International. Since December 2023, he has also appeared as a guest on the YouTube series Qafqaz Xəbərləri.

Akhundov began his career in the late 1980s, working in the healthcare sector before transitioning into education, where he taught Russian and English and conducted extracurricular courses on Baku's history. His passion for the city's heritage has shaped his lifelong commitment to public education and historical preservation.

He holds a bachelor's degree in Oriental Studies from Baku State University and earned a Master of Public Administration from Harvard University's Kennedy School of Government in 2001. He later completed a Master of Arts in Education at the University of Toronto's Ontario Institute for Studies in Education.

In assessing global energy security issues, he has regularly toured the Gulf and the Caspian, as well as visited the Alaskan North Slope, the Athabasca Tar Sands, China, Norway, and Venezuela. He has also testified to UK parliamentary committees on Turkish, Russian, Caspian, and Mideast energy security issues. He is currently researching shale gas development in China and hydrocarbons development in the Eastern Mediterranean and Northern Iraq.
